

Disciplinary Committee (DC) Review

According to [Chapter 8, Section 2\(f\)](#), “DC” means Disciplinary Committee. The DC may be comprised of:

- At least one (1) Board member; or
- Executive Director in [discipline matrix](#) process matters.

The DC will review the file and make a recommendation. In a typical investigation, file review may take two (2) weeks, but may take longer depending on the amount of information provided.

The DC may request more information prior to making a recommendation. For example, they may request a Substance Abuse Evaluation or a Mental Health Evaluation. ([See Chapter 8, Section 7](#))

The DC may meet informally with the licensee. ([See Chapter 8, Section 5 \(a\)\(iii\)](#))

Once the DC has sufficient information, a recommendation on the final resolution of the matter will be made.
